OFFICIAL RULES.

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT BY VETERANS FOR TICKETS TO EVENTS IS ALLOWED

VetTickets is operated by the Veterans and First Responders Foundation of Canada, 1684 Dufferin St., Toronto, ON, M6H 3M1, a federal not-for-profit corporation.

1. Former members of the Canadian Armed Forces who successfully underwent basic training and were released with an honourable discharge and are legal residents of Canada are eligible to receive tickets at no charge from VetTickets.
2. VetTickets operations are subject to all federal, provincial, and municipal laws, and is void where prohibited.
3. Employees of the VetTickets or any of its respective affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising agencies, or any other company or individual involved with the design, production execution or distribution of the tickets and their immediate family (spouse, parents and step-parents, siblings and step-siblings, and children and step-children) and household members (people who share the same residence at least three (3) months out of the year) of each such employee are not eligible for tickets.
4. Participation constitutes full and unconditional agreement to these Official Rules and VetTickets' decisions, which are final and binding in all matters related to the operation of the website and distribution of tickets. Receiving tickets is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein.
- 5 Registration is free. Eligible Veterans must provide their first name, last name, email address, telephone number, country and state/province of residence.
6. Tickets can be distributed through local Veterans group, local agencies or directly through the website. We expect that demand will exceed supply and we will not be able to fulfill requests.
7. Recipients of tickets agree that their name, rank, city of residence, likeness and photographic or video image, may be used in perpetuity, on the website, in promotional material and social media by VetTickets.
8. Veterans may register on the website to receive special news and updates from VetTickets. Registration will sign the registrant up to the VetTickets Insider email newsletter. Information about how email data will be used can be found at www.Vettickets.ca/privacy. You can unsubscribe at any time.
9. Registration become the property of VetTickets and will not be acknowledged or returned.

10. VetTickets reserves the right to delete or remove participants that are in violation of the Official Rules.

11. By participating on VetTickets, entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules.

12. Registrants Consent to the announcement of the recipients' name and the use by or on behalf of VetTickets of the recipient's name and/or photograph and/or video for advertising and promotional purposes, without any further compensation.

13. Should the selected recipient fail to comply with any of the requirements contained in these Official Rules, or not be available to be reached within time limits set by VetTickets in their sole and unfettered discretion, tickets will be automatically forfeited and another registrant will be selected and the initially selected registrant will be disqualified and will have no recourse towards VetTickets or anyone involved in the website or its sponsors or partner organizations.

14. Return of any ticket notification email as "undeliverable" may result in disqualification, and an alternate recipient may be selected.

15. VetTickets as an intermediary in the distribution process. Tickets will be distributed as they become available. In the event of an issue with any donated tickets, VetTickets will endeavour to supply tickets to an alternate event to the same recipient; said recipient agrees this is full and complete compensation for any issues that arise with respect to those tickets.

16. VetTickets will endeavour to supply tickets in pairs, for eligible veterans and a companion or attendant but there may be occasions where single seats only are available.

17. Registrants agree that they must attend events in person and use one of the tickets supplied by VetTickets for their own personal use. If they are unable to attend for any reason, they must return the tickets to VetTickets. Tickets cannot be resold or transferred to any other without the express permission in writing of VetTickets. Tickets must be accepted as awarded. No cash alternatives, substitution or transfers of the tickets will be allowed.

18. Tickets do not include any expenses related to meals, pre- and post-travel arrangements, quarantine costs associated with covid-19 travel requirements, hotel incidentals (phone, laundry, spa treatments, etc.), gratuities, or any applicable taxes, which are the sole responsibility of ticket recipients.

19. Tickets are subject to availability, weather conditions and operating times of each activity provider.

20. Vettickets reserves the right to substitute tickets in whole or in part without any compensation to recipients.

21. Ticket recipient is not entitled to receive any payment for any possible difference between the actual value of the tickets their estimated values.

22.. In the event that there are government regulations in in Canada restricting gatherings or travel at the time of the ticketed event, VetTickets will make best efforts to coordinate a rescheduled date for the event. If Donors are unable or unwilling to reschedule and provide tickets to alternate events because of such regulations or related circumstances, then the tickets shall become null and void and the recipient will not be entitled to any compensation.

23. VetTickets operations are subject to all applicable federal, provincial and local/municipal laws and is void where prohibited by law.

24. If any provision of these Official Rules is found by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, all other provisions will remain in full force and effect.

25. Vettickets will not, under any circumstances, be responsible for, or liable to any registrant or any other person for: any erroneous lost, damaged, late, incomplete, misdirected, deleted, defective, or altered registrations, regardless of the cause, including, but not limited to, failure of the Site; any failure for any reason whatsoever of the selected recipient to receive a prize notification; any changes in email addresses after Contest registrations are submitted; and any computer, online, telephone, or technical malfunctions or errors that may occur, regardless of the cause.

26. If for any reason the ticket distribution is not capable of being conducted as intended by the VetTickets, including due to computer viruses, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other cause that corrupts or interferes with the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the website, VetTickets may, at its sole discretion, disqualify any entrant responsible for such misconduct and cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend operations and implement new operations and/or procedures in its sole and absolute discretion.

27. Should tax liability arise, then it will be the responsibility of the winner to notify their own Government's relevant tax department. VetTickets takes no responsibility or liability for taxation or for any other costs incurred in connection with the tickets received.

28. Decisions of VetTickets are final and binding in tier sole and absolute discretion.

29. By registration or acceptance of tickets, participants consent to VetTickets collection, use, and disclosure of the personal information provided in the registration for administration, including posting of the recipient's name, rank, photograph, likeness or video image, and city of residence on the VetTickets website, on social media including but not limited to Facebook, Twitter and Instagram, and in aggregated, nonpersonal form in order to create reports regarding demographics and consumer habits, which reports VetTickets may disclose to others. VetTickets will use the registrant's personal information only for identified purposes and protect the registrant's personal information in a manner that is consistent with the VetTickets Privacy Policy at: <http://www.vettickets.ca/privacy/>. Registrants may write to VetTickets and request that their information be removed from VetTickets records.

30. Recipients of tickets agree that they will not consume illicit drugs and/or excessive amounts of alcohol before, during, or directly after attending any event accessed with Tickets
